

These charts represent sizing averages to help you when making hats and booties for babies and children that you can not measure yourself because they are far away, uncooperative or it is a gift and you don't want Mom and Dad to know. The measurements come from surfing *wonderful websites to find different charts and then doing a little averaging of my own. Babies come in all shapes and sizes so when in doubt, enlarge.

Two things I realized while doing this: boy's feet tend to be smaller and their heads larger than girls of the same age (no comment) and all baby's heads are large (as any mother can attest to) and grow quickly so that by the age of three or four, they are just about as large as a small adult head. Isn't that amazing?

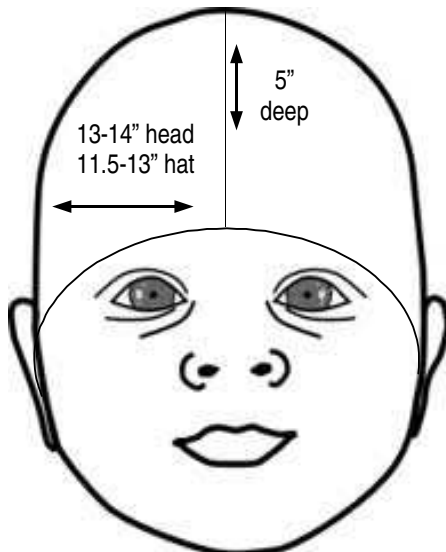

Average Head Measurements for Knitted Hats

Actual Head Circumference: measure around head above the brows and over the tops of the ears.

Hat Size: decrease actual measurement by 1.5-2" for snug fit and stretch-ability.

Head Depth: measure from the ear lobe base to the top center of the crown.
